

## **Guests at in Public Spaces**

Visitors, regardless of vaccination status, are now welcomed to attend community events and programming as capacity allows, gather in community spaces, and dine with residents in the Bistro.

The monthly LifeStreams calendar and event postings will state “Sorry, no guests” when guests cannot be accommodated.

We are unable to monitor the vaccination status of guests. In order to safeguard the health and wellbeing of Saint John’s, guests will be required to wear a face covering during events and programming regardless of vaccination status.

Guests in the care neighborhoods are permitted to dine with residents only in the resident’s room; guests may not dine in the dining room.

## **Face Coverings**

Face coverings continue to be required for all residents in common spaces, such as elevators and hallways while moving about campus.

All Saint John’s employees will continue to wear face coverings while interacting with residents or in public spaces.

All visitors above age two, regardless of vaccination status, should wear a well-fitting face covering and physically distance from others while in public or common areas.
