Saint John's Visitation Policy

We continue to strongly encourage all visitors to be vaccinated. We welcome all visitors regardless of age or vaccination status. All visitors will be screened at the Resident Service desks for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and will have their temperatures checked. The CDC has lifted the mask requirement for fully vaccinated individuals in public areas with exception for Health Care settings such as Saint John's. Per CDC guidelines, visitors who are aged two or older, regardless of vaccination status, are required to wear a well-fitting face covering and physically distance from others while in public or common areas.

Saint John's does not limit the number of visitors a resident may receive. However, programming throughout the building is limited to residents ONLY. Visitors are prohibited from participating in programming with residents.
