

COVID Booster Clinic Planned

The next vaccine clinic will be held **Wednesday, June 22 in the NCAC**. Appointments will be available as early as 10:00am and run throughout the day. The Moderna vaccine will be the only one available, but they will be able to offer both the first and second boosters. If you would like to schedule an appointment to receive a booster on June 22, please contact the Wellness Center at 831-6876.

To receive a **first** booster, you must be at least 18 years old, and it must be 5 months since you completed your primary series (the first two shots).

To receive a **second** booster, you must be at least 50 years old, and it must be 4 months since your first booster. You may also be eligible if you are under 50, but severely immunocompromised.

No Changes to Current COVID Precautions

Please remain vigilant about your own precautions. The level of virus activity in Milwaukee County continues to be elevated, and your risk of exposure is high. While we can all be thankful the risk of severe illness or death is lessened, we should not become inattentive to basic safety measures like appropriate mask use, distancing when possible, and consistent handwashing. Current precautions remain unchanged:

- In-person dining is permitted in Taylor's and the Bistro. Carry out food is still available if you prefer.
- Guests are permitted in all dining venues, as well as to attend LifeStreams programming.
- **Residents should always wear masks when outside your apartments.**
- Guests and visitors should always wear face masks when in any common or public area.
- Employees will always wear face masks when interacting with residents or when in large group meetings.
